1. Submission of this application form and invitation to the introductory skate camp should not be interpreted as acceptance into the training program. Those inducted into the program will receive confirmation letters.
2. It is recommended that applicants do not purchase referee equipment until they have received confirmation of acceptance into the RDP and successfully completed the Hockey Canada certification clinic.
3. Only those receiving confirmation of acceptance will be invited to the Hockey Canada certification clinic.
4. Successful applicants are expected to treat officiating like a career occupation.
5. Successful applicants are not guaranteed a certain amount of games per year. Games are assigned based on availability, reliability, and are done by volunteers who try to assign as fairly as possible.
6. Typically, new officials should not expect to make a certain amount of money on their first season. As an official's ability and competencies increase with experience, more games are made available.
7. New officials must be proficient skaters. The Referee-In-Chief reserves the right to decline an applicant if their skating ability may compromise the safety of the official and their ability to safely manage a sanctioned hockey game. Officials are expected to be able to skate at the level of the player's they are officiating or better.
8. Officials must have a working e-mail address which they check frequently and they must have access to the internet to receive games.
