#### 1. BASIS OF ACCOUNTING

The basis of accounting applied in the preparation of the statement of financial position of South Delta Minor Hockey Association as at April 30, 2022, and the statements of changes in net assets and revenues and expenditures for the year then ended is the historical cost basis and reflects cash transactions with the addition of:

- investments recorded at cost
- property, plant and equipment amortized on the same basis as for income tax
- accounts payable and accrued liabilities
- unearned registration fees

#### 2. DESCRIPTION OF BUSINESS

The South Delta Minor Hockey Association is incorporated under the Society Act of British Columbia.

The Gaming Grant bank account represents unspent gaming funds received by the association. The funds received for the gaming grant help pay for ice rental.

#### 4. RESTRICTED CASH

The Association has internally restricted funds of \$140,000. These internal restrictions were established to ensure uninterrupted future operations in the event of reduced funding as the Association does not have established credit facilities with its bank.

An additional \$60,000 from the 2020 surplus were internally restricted. The purpose of the internal restriction was to allow for a reduction of 2021-22 registration fees. These amounts were utilized in 2021-22.

Additional funds of \$60,000 were internally restricted in 2022 for rebranding and jersey replacement to take place in future years.
