SDMHA VOLUNTEER QUALIFICATION PROGRAM

The following is a list (not exhaustive) of acceptable duties that parents can undertake to fulfill their volunteer hours:

Team Level:

- Coordinating fundraising – 50/50, etc.
- Tournament coordinator (road trips, hotels etc.)
- Treasurer
- Volunteer Coordinator
- Scorekeeping Scheduler
- Team Safety Person (minimum of 2 per team)
- Jersey Parent (2 – 4 parents per team)
- Dressing Room Cleanup
- Tournament assistance
- Team Manager
- Time Clock (at least 4 times)

At the end of the season, the Team Manager for each team will be asked to supply the Administrator with a list of those parents that did not fulfill their volunteer hours for the team.

Association Level:

- Picture Day
- Party in Da House Tournament
- Tim Jardine Tournament
- Apparel Fitting Day
- Equipment Distribution/Return
- Coordinating 50/50 Night

There will be other opportunities throughout the season as help is required. The Administrator will publish these requests as they arise.

\$150 cheque post dated March 1, 2017 must be received from each family. Please keep your teams cheques on file until March 1, 2017. We suggest that each team have a “volunteer coordinator” to track your team families required 6 hours of volunteer work.

Head/Assistant coaches, Division/Team managers and safety people are **exempt** from writing a cheque. Please make note of this on your tracking sheet.

Volunteer cheques for those families that did not fulfill their volunteer obligations may be cashed as early as **March 1, 2017.**
